

Mayor kicks off 2017 infill construction season

With all that's been done to improve infill construction practices in Edmonton, the 2017 infill construction season is shaping up to be the best yet.

That's why Mayor Don Iveson joined City staff, community members and industry representatives at an infill site in Edmonton today to mark this new beginning.

"Infill helps make the best use of our existing infrastructure and creates more housing options for Edmontonians and their families, which is important for the social sustainability of our City over the short and long term," said Mayor Don Iveson.

Earlier this year, in January, Citystaff completed an Infill Roadman Summary Report that included updates on all Roadmap Action

items and related detours. The detours came from public feedback along the way, feedback that helped fuel a swath of changes to how the City engages with both infill developers and neighbours of infill.

"We've really listened, to industry, stakeholders and Edmontonians," said Livia Balone, Director of Development and Zoning Services, who also spoke at the event, "the result is a robust set of infill initiatives that are starting to really make a difference in how infill in Edmonton can and should be done."
