## LRT trains run every 20 minutes on Sunday Metro Line runs between Bay/Enterprise and NAIT stations only

Customers are encouraged to leave extra time and plan ahead if traveling on the Metro or Capital Line on Sunday, April 23 from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. Trains on both lines will run every 20 minutes in order to complete planned track-level maintenance as safely and as quickly as possible. Metro and Capital Line trains usually run on a 15-minute frequency on Sundays.

Metro Line trains will operate between Bay/Enterprise Square and NAT stations only. Passengers travelling further south of Bay/Enterprise Square will need to transfer to a Capital Line train marked "Century Park."

ETS riders will need to use Track 1 to board Capital Line trains in both directions at Bay/Enterprise Square, Corona and Grandin/Government Centre LRT stations.

During this time, LRT arrival signs will not be in service. Customers are encouraged to plan ahead through the Transit Trip Planner at takeETS.com.
