LRT trains run every 20 minutes on Sunday

Metro Line runs between Bay/Enterprise and NAIT stations only

April 21, 2017

Customers are encouraged to leave extra time and plan ahead if traveling on the Metro or Capital Line on Sunday, April 23 from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. Trains on both lines will run every 20 minutes in order to complete planned track-level maintenance as safely and as quickly as possible. Metro and Capital Line trains usually run on a 15-minute frequency on Sundays.

Metro Line trains will operate between Bay/Enterprise Square and NAIT stations only. Passengers travelling further south of Bay/Enterprise Square will need to transfer to a Capital Line train marked "Century Park."

ETS riders will need to use Track 1 to board Capital Line trains in both directions at Bay/Enterprise Square, Corona and Grandin/Government Centre LRT stations.

During this time, LRT arrival signs will not be in service. Customers are encouraged to plan ahead through the Transit Trip Planner at akeETS.com.
