

## ETS spring bus schedule changes start April 30

April 26, 2017

Transit riders are reminded to plan ahead as spring service changes take effect on Sunday, April 30. The frequency of service is being reduced for post-secondary routes, school specials and 22 bus routes in order to accommodate spring ridership patterns associated with post-secondary schedule changes and breaks.

There will be detours and schedule changes to allow for longer travel time on some routes impacted by construction. In preparation for the Downtown Bike Network, Route 52 and 309 will shift service at 100 Avenue and 103 Street to 107 Street and Jasper Avenue, and Route 70 will now travel clockwise along the downtown loop.

Time will be added to numerous route schedules in order to maintain connections at Milgate, Mil Woods and Meadows Transit Centres during construction of the Valley Line LRT. Departure and arrival times at transit centres are unaffected.

Transit riders are encouraged to double check bus schedules and use real-time tools to plan their commute.
