The Whitemud Park Boardwalk and staircase create a vital trail connection within the Whitemud Creek Ravine in Whitemud Park, allowing passage through an area that is often too wet or muddy to cross. The aging boardwalk has become increasingly worn and significantly damaged by ice heave. As a result, the boardwalk surface poses potential safety concerns. A project has been initiated to replace this boardwalk with a more durable and pedestrian-friendly solution.
