



The City of Edmonton's *Laurel Green* Green Building Grant Program

Stage 10 – City-owned Lots

The City of Edmonton requires that all new homes built on the City-owned lots in *Laurel Green* (www.edmonton.ca/laurelgreen) reach an EnerGuide rating of 80 and be ready for solar pv panels (solar photovoltaic panels).

For those who wish to exceed that standard, City Environmental Strategies, through the Green Building Policy, is offering a limited-time grant program to encourage builders and homebuyers purchasing one of the City-owned lots in *Laurel Green* to construct homes that exceed the EnerGuide 80 rating.

The following grant amounts are available on the final, 3rd party verified EnerGuide rating of the applicant's home in *Laurel Green*:

- \$3,000 for achieving EnerGuide 82-83*
- \$5,000 for achieving EnerGuide 84-85*
- \$7,000 for achieving EnerGuide 86 or better*

Builders and homeowners whose home meets the standards above as verified by an approved Certified Energy Advisor will receive their *Laurel Green* Green Building Grant at the time that their Sustainability and Architectural Design Guideline Performance Fee is returned by the City.

This funding is available to NEW home buyers and builders who purchased a City-owned lot in the *Laurel Green* neighbourhood in southeast Edmonton. Homes in other parts of *Laurel Green* do not qualify for the grant.
