## Waste Services



Soon, your building/property will have separate bins or carts for food scraps, recycling and garbage.

You'll be asked to sort your food scraps, recycling and garbage in your home, then take them to your building's bins or carts. You'll receive a pail for storing food scraps in your home, along with information to get you started.

Here's what you can do to get ready:



- ☐ Think about where in your home you will store your food scraps pail and a bag or box for recyclables.
  - The food scraps pail is about as big as a box of 12 pop cans. It should fit under your sink or on your counter.
- Visit edmonton.ca/Waste and click "Apartment and Condo Collection Changes" (or scan the QR code) to find out more about the program.

## Here's why this change is happening:

- It helps the environment by keeping waste out of the landfill.
- It will help the cost of waste services stay stable.
- It means all Edmontonians will dispose of their waste in the same way—whether they live in an apartment or in a detached home.

A few weeks after you receive your food scraps pail, a City of Edmonton Waste Outreach Educator will knock on your door to answer any guestions.
